**21—JESSE McALLISTER**, <sup>3</sup>, (Richard, <sup>2</sup>, Archibald, <sup>1</sup>), b. Dec. 23, 1768, d. 1850, was the youngest son of Col. Richard McAllister, of Hanover, York County, Pa. He lived on a farm between Littlestown and Gettysburg until his death, and was buried in Mt. Olivet Cemetery, Hanover, Pa. He married Elizabeth Weems, a descendant of the English family of that name, and had issue:——
